



## Requirements

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### *School Attendance*

Students are required to attend a **minimum of 80 percent** of all classes. Email your child's teacher and the principal if your child will be absent.

### *Synagogue Attendance*

Shalom School encourages service attendance as a standard for family practice.

### *Snacks, Kashrut and allergies*

Please do not send any food or drinks with your child, snack will be provided. Shalom School is a **Peanut-Free zone**.

### *Door Duty*

Parents are asked to help with security by covering door duty on Sundays from 9:15am to 9:40am and 12:15pm to 12:40pm **two times a year**.

### *Vaccination*

You will be required to present a copy of your child/ren immunization record on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of school.

### *Cell phones*

If brought to school, electronic devices should be turned off.

### *Tzedakah*

To be brought by your child every session.

### *Tuition*

Due no later than **August 13**. If you choose to pay in two installments, the second payment is due **January 15, 2024**.

### *Scholarship*

Application must be made at the beginning of the school year.

# Programs & Hours

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*Sunday School 9:30am-12:30pm* (for grade Pre-K to 6th) at Congregation Mickve Israel (CMI)

*Wednesday program 4:30-6:10pm* (3rd-6th grade) at Agudath Achim synagogue (AA)

*Hebrew Private Tutoring as an alternative to Wednesday* (3rd grade & up)  
The tutoring program is based on the completion of 22 sessions to validate a full year.

*Seventh grade and Up* meet at Mickve Israel every other Sunday.

*Madrichim Program* (teacher in training) 8<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grade students on Sundays that students do not have classes with their grade.

## Hebrew Instruction

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*Hebrew Placement:* Hebrew instruction will be offered by proficiency level and not by grade and students will be evaluated on the first day of school.

As your children embark on their journey of learning Hebrew, we would like to emphasize the importance of regular practice and review in between sessions to support their understanding of Hebrew letters, vowels, and basic reading skills. We kindly request your assistance in motivating your children to dedicate time to practice Hebrew outside of Sunday School, as it will greatly enhance their overall learning experience.
